City Attorney David Mecklin reported that no action was taken other than allowing the City Attorney to meet with the Mayor to mediate a resolution to the current investigation.

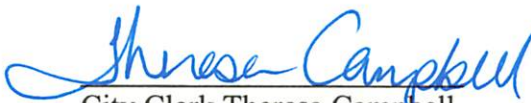

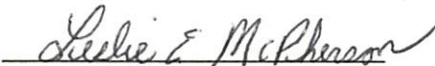
Irene Carlo- Mentioned current special called meeting was confusing and believes better communication to the public is needed.
